Alfred Nzo district Municipality hereby invites interested engineering professional service providers or consortium to submit proposals for the preparation of detailed feasibility study for the following bulk water contracts;

DOCUMENTATION

A non-refundable deposit of **R500.00** (either cash or bank guaranteed cheque in favour of Alfred Nzo District Municipality) is required per document.

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work includes the following:

Planning, design, and construction management of the bulk water supply components of the Scheme, to be undertaken in a phased manner over the next few years, based on priorities within the area and the availability of funding.

Planning of the entire Scheme will be done in two separate studies, viz.

(i) Feasibility Study 1:

Detailed feasibility study for the raw water supply system (including a dam, abstraction works, pump station, and rising main); and

(ii) Feasibility Study 2:

Detailed feasibility study for the treated bulk water supply infrastructure (including the linking into existing standalone schemes in various wards in Matatiele Local Municipal areas, bulk pipelines, reservoirs and pump stations)

A compulsory project clarification meeting will be held on, **17th February 2012 @ 11:00** and Bidders are required to meet Alfred Nzo District Municipal Officials in the Municipal Infrastructure Boardroom in Mount Ayliff at.

Bidders shall take note of the following bid conditions

- Original Valid Tax Clearance Certificate
- Certified copies of originals of company registration documents and ID documents of members
- Company Profile with traceable references
- JV agreement (where applicable)
- BBEEE Certified Certificate issued by a credited service provider

- Bidders are required to submit Proposed Project Team, their CV's and qualification
- Proof of professional registration with (CESA) Consulting Engineers South Africa
- Proof of staff registration with the Engineering Council of South Africa (ECSA) need to be submitted
- The two envelope tender system will be followed and failure to comply with this requirement will result in the tender being disqualified
- Bidders need to register with the Alfred Nzo District Municipality database

Failure to supply all required information will result in the bid being deemed non-responsive; and therefore the bid will not be considered forward.

PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT (PPPFA) POINTS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS

The tender will be adjudicated on the basis of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (Act No.5, 2000), and the regulations pertaining thereto (2001), as well as the Alfred Nzo District Municipality's Supply Chain Management policy

Two envelope system will be used and therefore Technical proposals and financial proposals must BE submitted in different sealed envelopes clearly marked **The contract No and Name** as per table below and deposited in the tender box at Alfred Nzo district municipality offices in Mt Ayliff not later than **12:00 pm, 14 March 2012** on that day only the technical proposals will be opened in public.

Received Responsive Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria;

The bid will be evaluated in two stages namely:

- Stage 1 - Functionality
- Stage 2 - Price and B-BBEE Certification

Only Bidders who score 80% or more on stage 1 would be evaluated further and therefore eligible for the award.

Bidders scored less than 80% of the total weight will not be considered further for price.

Shortlisted candidates will be requested to do a presentation
