



**CALL FOR SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS FROM INTERESTED AND PROSPECTIVE PARTICIPANTS TO MANUFACTURING OF A CONSTRUCTION RELATED BUILDING MATERIAL PROGRAMME AT ANDM ZONE CENTRES LOCATED IN MATATIELE AND UMZIMVUBU**

**1. BACKGROUND**

Over the years, ANDM has have embarked on a process of establishing 5 Zone Centres in Matatiele and Umzimvubu jurisdictions for manufacturing of VIP related material for a sanitation programme that sought to address backlogs that was identified in the provision of sanitation in the aforesaid Municipalities. Nevertheless, the sanitation programme was completed and the established Zone Centres were left under-utilized and thereby exposed to community vandalism.

**2. CALL FOR APPLICATIONS:**

To ensure that these centres are not vandalized and are optimal used for both benefit of the municipality and affected communities, ANDM wishes to call all interested and prospective beneficiaries to submit proposals to participate to manufacturing of construction related building material programme in ANDM zone centres. The programme consists of the following components:

**2.1. Training**

- ❖ Classroom Training
- ❖ Technical Training (venue based training and site based training)
- ❖ Mentorship

**2.2. Allocation of Zone Centres**

- ❖ Meggie Resha (Matatiele)
- ❖ Madiba (Matatiele)
- ❖ Mpakamesi Mhlaba (Matatiele)
- ❖ Shinta (Umzimvubu \_ Mt Frere)
- ❖ Baffalonek (Umzimvubu \_ Mt Frere)

**3. PROGRAMME OVERALL OBJECTIVE**

To support SMMEs and promote locally based manufacturing for building material in order to create employment opportunities, maximize profit for local enterprises, and in turn reduce economic leakages ascribed from missed economic opportunities within the District.

**4. SCOPE & EXTENT OF WORK**

SMMEs are invited to submit their proposals to participate in a manufacturing of building material programme for a period of 3 years. The prospective participants are expected to complete the programs' duration and abide by the terms and conditions of the programme, which will be prearranged by the ANDM. As part of the programme, the participants will ultimately be allocated with Zone centres as stated above.

## **5. EXPECTED OUTCOMES OF THE PROGRAMME**

- The project key output or deliverable is a call for submission of proposals from interested and prospective participants to a construction and manufacturing of building material programme in ANDM zone centres located in Matatiele and Umzimvubu.
- That the participants would establish their own site after it completed the programme
- That the participants would have been trained to improve their technical capacity
- That the participants would have acquired sand or quarry mining permit
- That the participant would have acquired water use license
- That the product's participant would have approved by South African Bureau Standards.

## **6. CONDITIONS FOR CONSIDERATION: (To be eligible for qualifying, the following criteria must have been met)**

- The interested participants must be within the Alfred Nzo District Jurisdiction.
- The interested participants' entity must have company registration certificate, tax clearance certificate/pin and BBBEE certificate/affidavit.
- The participant's entity residential address in its company registration certificate must reflect to be within Alfred Nzo District Jurisdiction.
- The interested participants must provide proof of residence from ward councillor or statement of paying water bills.
- The entity that reflects youth, women and people with people living with disabilities as its directors will be the first preference.
- The interested participants must demonstrate innovation in its proposal

## **7. PROJECT PROPOSAL DETAILS**

### **7.1. Training**

The project proposal must contain the following:

- The SMME/prospective participants must indicate whether is currently in operations of building blocks and bricks or manufacturing of any building/construction related product.
- If yes, it must consolidate a comprehensive company profile coupled with an indication of the proposed project team in the current operations
- If no, it must consolidate a proposed comprehensive company profile coupled with an indication of the proposed project team should it be operational.
- The SMME/prospective participants must indicate on the areas of training needs in classroom or technical or both components.

### **7.2. Zone Centre Allocation**

- The five aforementioned Zone Centres will be allocated to participated beneficiaries or SMMEs post the completion of the training.
- The Participated SMMEs will be assessed based on the training tasks given to SMMEs {classroom (summative and formative) and practical/technical training}.
- The successful SMMEs will have to develop proposal that demonstrate innovation on the utilization of Zone Centres.
- Clear indicate the projected operational expenditure for the duration of the operations of three years
- SMMEs will have to develop a plan that indicates a number of job opportunities
- SMMEs must note that the members of the affected communities should gain first preference in the created jobs opportunities should it be allocated with Zone Centre. In a case where the members of the affected communities are inadequate or do not meet the requirements of the job, members from other communities within the ward should be considered

- Provide an indication of protective clothing and other working tools to be utilized in implementing the proposed business activity outlined in the proposal.
