1.1 INTRODUCTION

The department of IDMS in Alfred Nzo District Municipality (ANDM) is expediting the response to the major concern of the primary service of supplying communities with the basic services of clean water and decent sanitation within the district. ANDM is composed of the Umzimvubu, Ntabankulu, Bizana and Ntabankulu Local Municipalities.

Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 emphasises on the role of the municipality to provide clean and safe environment that will promote sustainable development and service delivery. At the same time the Water Services Act is clear about the role that WSA Municipalities must play in provisioning of clean drinking water and disposal of safe effluent into the natural environment.

1.2 OVERALL AND SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

1.2.1 Overall objective

- The primary purpose of this project is to get a service provider for hiring of water carting trucks for the delivery of water to certain areas in Ntabankulu LM
- The truck will be expected to assist various number of villages and surrounding townships in Ntabankulu town.
- This project will assist the municipality in ensuring that water is delivered to the needy areas.

1.2.2 Specific objectives/requirements

- Supply and delivery of water through a proper water carting truck.
- Deliver water to specified areas as per the instruction from the Ntabankulu satellite office.
- Keep records for all water delivered as per the instructions from the satellite office.

2. SCOPE AND EXTENT OF WORK

Bids are invited from suitably qualified service providers to submit quotations to undertake supply and delivery of water to various areas in Ntabankulu LM.

The scope of work entails, supply and delivery of water to various areas of Ntabankulu including areas around the town as well as the rural villages.

The service provider will collect water from the municipal water sources and deliver to the areas that will be indicated.

3. PROJECT TIMEFRAME

The carting of water carting trucks will be sourced for delivery of water as and when required, the appointed service provider will await for instruction to deliver to specific areas.

4. KEY OUTPUTS/PROJECT MILESTONES/DELIVERABLES

The successful supplier will assist the Municipality by undertaking amongst other thing the following tasks/ items:

- Supply and delivery of estimated quantity of water to Ntabankulu area with a radius of 60kms.
- Deliver water to specified areas as per the instruction from the Ntabankulu satellite office.
- Keep records for all water delivered as per the instructions from the satellite office.
- The water carting truck must be either be normal water carting truck or a flatbed/dropside truck mounted with plastic tanks.
- The water tanks/ tanker must properly close to prevent water contamination.

6. PROJECT MANAGEMENT

The supply and delivery is to be coordinated and managed by WSP office management in Matatiele LM.

In cases where the appointed service provider appoints the services of other service provider or sub-contractor, the appointed service provider will take full responsibility of the work done by the sub-contractor. The client will deal with the contracted service provider and not with sub-contracted contractors/supplier. The project is to be coordinated and managed by WSP Section (Operations team of Matatiele LM).

7. REPORTING MECHANISM

It is expected that regular records of water carting will be made available for every payment request made. The Project Manager has the right to change the manner in which the records must be submitted.

8. SUBMISSION OF QUOTATIONS

Quotations must be emailed to tenders@andm.gov.za referenced with Bid Number, failure to do so will lead to disqualification.

9. CAPACITY TO EXECUTE THE WORK

Evaluation criteria of the Quotations;

The Quotations will be evaluated in two stages, namely:

- Stage 1- Capacity to Execute Work
- Stage 2- Price and Specific Goal

Only Bidders who score 70% or more on stage 1 would be evaluated further and therefore eligible for the award
