

TERMS OF REFERENCE PROCUREMENT OF LABORATORY ANALYSIS PROTECTIVE CLOTHING FOR ANDM ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PRACTITIONERS - MHS 2023/24 FINANCIAL YEAR

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1. BACKGROUND AND OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT

1.1 INTRODUCTION

Municipal Health Services, as mandated by and set out in the National Health Act, Section 80 – 84, is mainly rendering services that are outdoors in the field, including inspection of premises (business and government), investigation of or attending to environmental health related complaints, taking samples of water and food for monitoring purposes, community based awareness, attending meetings with other stakeholders and communities, monitoring exhumations and reburial of human remains and so on. These services are done irrespective of the weather conditions: either hot or cold. It is therefore necessary that during any weather condition the officials wear branded (to be able to be identified) protective clothing (blazers and sensible shoes).

1.2 OVERALL AND SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

1.2.1 Overall objective

ANDM MHS aims at securing a service provider to procure appropriate protective clothing for an EHP to be safe and identifiable when rendering the service, having these will enable EHPs to make a mark in a positive manner/impact in health status of the communities of ANDM. This will result in a remarkable decrease of diseases and increased life expectancy.

1.2.2 Specific Objectives

The specific objectives of the project require the undertaking of the following:

Procurement of 38 branded Blazers and 38 Midsole foam Shoe with hydrohesion rubber outsole

2. SCOPE & EXTENT OF WORK

Quotations are invited from suitably qualified professional service providers to prepare and submit proposals to undertake the procurement of personal protective clothing (PPC) for ANDM Environmental Health Practitioners-MHS

It is compulsory that the appointed service provider must first engage with the Project Manager to get clarity on the items to be procured

Upon agreement with the Project Manager the service provider must:

- procure 38 branded Blazers and 38 Midsole foam Shoe with hydrohesion rubber outsole
- verify sizes of each individual and bring samples of each item to be procured
- ensure that all clothing are embroidered and of durable quality (SABS) as of specification

5. PROJECT MANAGEMENT

In cases where the appointed service provider appoints the services of other consultants, the appointed service provider will take responsibility of the work. The client will deal with the contracted service provider. The project is to be coordinated and managed by an operational team led by Alfred Nzo District Municipality.

6. REPORTING MECHANISM

It is expected that regular progress reports will be communicated with the Project Manager on a Weekly basis.

7. SUBMISSION OF BIDS

Quotations must be placed in a sealed envelope and clearly marked:

"PROCUREMENT OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE CLOTHING (PPC) FOR ANDM ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH PRACTITIONERS – MHS" and placed in the Bid box in the Alfred Nzo District Municipality not later than 12H00

8. CAPACITY TO EXECUTE THE WORK

Evaluation criteria of the Quotations:

The quotations will be evaluated in two stages, namely:

- Stage 1- Capacity to Execute Work
- Stage 2- Price and Specific Goal

Only Bidders who score 70% or more on stage 1 would be evaluated further and therefore eligible for the award

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Price and Preference

Quotations will be evaluated according to the 80/20 Point System in compliance with Preferential Procurement Policy Act (5/2000) and Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022.
