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1. BACKGROUND AND OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT

1.1 INTRODUCTION

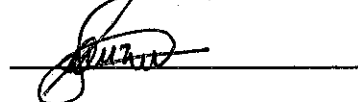

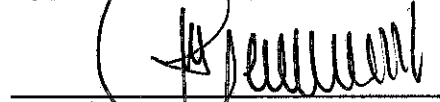
